WHY LODDON ON CALL NEEDS YOU

Loddon On Call needs your help to maintain the service it provides to Loddon and the surrounding parishes. Since our scheme began responding 18 months ago, we have received over 800 emergency 999 calls to provide immediate medical assistance prior to the emergency services arrival. The scheme aims to provide 24/7 cover but in order to achieve this we need your help. Can you give a few hours between Monday and Friday? It could be one block or spread over a few days - the choice is yours. We can provide full training, equipment and safety clothing - all we ask you to give is your time.

LODDON ON CALL DETAILS

Loddon on Call is based at Loddon Fire Station and has been running for 18 months.

The scheme vehicle responds to calls placed to the Ambulance call centre and carries a Defibrillator for cardiac arrests, oxygen for asthma attacks and Hypo stop for diabetics, along with normal first aid supplies.

The Loddon On Call scheme is self funded by fundraising events and donations.

From January to November 2007, Loddon on Call responded to 5 call outs in Ashby St Mary alone and in a 10 mile radius of Loddon has used its defibrillator 4 times.
